Synopsis

Arizona, 1880. A handsome young *half-Mexican, half-Anglo* returns to *Arizona* after a five year absence believing *Apaches* had murdered his parents and brother only to discover the identity of the real killer.

In a riveting, action-filled western epic he sets out to exact his revenge.

Along the way he is torn between the love of two beautiful women and the brutal murder of his closest friends and adopted family by the same killer who turns out to be someone he never suspected. Events build at an electrifying pace until the explosive climax which pits the two adversaries in a fight to the death.

Concept

The Sunset Rider is a timely approach to a genre that has been around since the creation of the motion picture: ***The Western***.

What is most unique about this project is that it has a handsome Latino hero and an Anglo villain.

Three of the six major supporting characters are also Latino. Couple that with the ever-increasing growth of the *Latino* market for movies-which is now nearing a whopping 26% - and that's just in *North America*... and we are sitting on a platinum mine.

The picture is to be shot in the rugged beauty of the *South West*, the grandeur of *Monument Valley*, *Utah* and against the fiery red sunsets and *Saguaro* cactus of *Tucson, Arizona* to the fully orchestrated score of composer **Lee Holdridge** (*Old Gringo, Brothers at War*) to give the picture the epic look and feel of the old west. To further enhance the realism we plan to use *Native Americans* from the *Navajo Nation* to portray *Apaches* in the story.

We are pulling out all the stops on this project because the overriding objective is to tell a good story with dynamic characters that will make an entertaining, highly profitable motion picture that will reach a very wide audience.



Jeff Hathcock

Writer, Director, Executive Producer

Jeff Hathcock made and sold his first film *Victims!* in 1982 and along with his next three films, *Night Ripper*, *Streets of Death*, with former Disney star Tommy Kirk and *Mark of the Beast* with Bo Hopkins and Robert Tessier which is considered to be a cult classic. These films are being reissued by various outlets around the country. These were followed by *Beastmaster 2* where Hathcock directed 2nd Unit wild animal sequences. Other films include *Children of the Road*, *Three Bad Men* with actor George Kennedy, *Marked Men*, with Jan-Michael Vincent, *The Alley* and *The Two Pamelas*—a film noir thriller which received a 9.1 rating on IMDb.

Jeff has also directed 180 stage productions, his last being *Enter Laughing* at the San Clemente Playhouse in 2019.

Hathcock has written 3 novels, *Cult of the Cobra*, *Eye of the Cobra*, and *The Society of Heaven and Earth* which are being published by *Righter's Mill Press* and *Three Corners Entertainment* in New Jersey. They are also optioned to produce as feature films.

Hathcock also wrote for Walt Disney Productions and while with Disney wrote for Walter Matthau and Jack Klugman.

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Kevin Sorbo

Executive Producer, Actor – Jack Lassiter

Kevin Sorbo received international stardom when he booked the lead role in *Hercules, the Legendary Journeys*, which became the most watched TV show in the world. Following that success, Sorbo had the lead role as *Captain Dylan Hunt* in *Gene Roddenberry's, Andromeda*.

Kevin's independent film *What If* was nominated for *Best Family Movie of the Year* by the *Movie Guide Awards*. Sorbo also received the *Movie Guide Award for Most Inspirational Performance of the Year*.

Sorbo starred in the faith-based movie, *God's Not Dead*. The \$2 million-dollar budgeted movie became the most successful independent faith-based movie ever with over \$140 million in theatrical, streaming and DVD sales.

Let There Be Light is a movie in which Kevin directed/acted/produced. This faith/family movie ranked number 4 out of the top 10 family movies of 2018.

Miracle in East Texas, a comedy based on a true story set in 1930, is another movie Sorbo directed/acted in. The movie release is scheduled for late 2022 and also stars *John Ratzenberger, Lou Gossett, Jr.* and *Sam Sorbo*.

The major motion picture, *Reagan*, with *Dennis Quaid* playing the late president—with Sorbo as his pastor—will be released in early 2023.

Kevin released his memoir *True Strength: My Journey from Hercules to Mere Mortal and How Nearly Dying Saved My Life*. The book chronicles his near-death experience after he suffered three strokes and his battle back to regain his life. He also co-wrote the follow up book, *True Faith, Embracing Adversity to Live in God's Light*, with his wife Sam. Sorbo resides in *Florida* with his wife Sam and three children.



Stan Holden

Executive Producer

Stan Holden has been a commercial creative director, graphic designer and cartoonist for most of his career—working professionally, even before graduating high school. His art was first published in a national magazine at the age of 12. Eventually the niche market of creating internal marketing, human resources design and employee morale campaigns for many Fortune 100 companies—such as *Disney, Pioneer, Toshiba, IBM* and *Apple*—became *Stan's* specialty.

Stan's work has been inducted into *The Museum of Television and Radio* and his work for *Apple* has been projected onto the sides of the *Mayan Pyramids in Machu Picchu, Peru* and the *Louvre museum in Paris, France*.

The process of creating communication design for the employee base of these companies allowed *Stan* to hone and perfect the skill of communicating in a fun and friendly way to large groups of people as well as individually, both visually and otherwise.

A tragic event that occurred during his childhood became the catalyst for *Stan's* passion to help others which led to a very successful sales career. By applying what he had learned from his design career to his sales career he was able to build a large international sales organization of over 3 million people.

Through his journey, *Stan* has been on the *PBS TV show, The American Health Journal*, has had his screenplay *Rebel Without A Claus* recommended by *Disney* and *STARZ* and optioned by *Showtime*. *Stan* is also an ongoing writer for *Chicken Soup For The Soul* and is working on his second and third books. **His first book *Giving Candy To Strangers* is a critically acclaimed best seller and is one of the few business books written from an artist's perspective.**

Danny Trejo

Actor – Grijalva

Danny Trejo was born Dan Trejo in Echo Park, Los Angeles, to Alice (Rivera) and Dan Trejo, a construction worker.


A child drug addict and criminal, *Trejo* was in and out of jail for 11 years. While serving time in *San Quentin*, he won the lightweight and welterweight boxing titles. Imprisoned for armed robbery and drug offenses, he successfully completed a 12-step rehabilitation program that changed his life.

While speaking at a *Cocaine Anonymous* meeting in 1985, *Trejo* met a young man who later called him for support. *Trejo* went to meet him at what turned out to be the set of *Runaway Train* (1985). Danny was immediately offered a role as a convict extra, probably because of his tough tattooed appearance. Also on the set was a screenwriter who did time with *Trejo* in *San Quentin*. Remembering *Trejo's* boxing skills, the screenwriter offered him a job to train the actors for a boxing match.

Director Andrey Konchalovskiy saw Trejo training Eric Roberts and immediately offered him a featured role as Roberts' opponent in the film. Trejo has subsequently appeared in many films throughout his career.

In 2019, *Trejo* played the roles of Jose in *Wish Man*, Eduardo Hernandez in *Grand-Daddy Day Care*, Miguel in *The Short History of the Long Road*, Carlos in *The Outsider*, Himself in *Madness in the Method*, Grave-digger in *Bullets of Justice*, Rondo in *3 From Hell* and Himself in *Slayer: The Repentless Killology*.

It was the funniest thing I'd ever heard. I'd been in Soledad, San Quentin, Folsom, Vacaville, Susanville, Sierra--and here's a guy asking, "Can you act like a convict?" I remember I said. "I'll give it a shot."



John Schneider

Actor – The Sheriff


It would be impressive enough for an actor to star in a single show that changed the course of television history with iconic characters and cross-generational appeal, but the fact that John Schneider's done exactly that on a consistent basis for at least four decades makes him nothing short of legendary. Whether it's playing *Jim Cryer* on *Tyler Perry's The Haves and the Have Nots*, immortalizing *Jonathan Kent* on *Smallville* and *Bo Duke* on *The Dukes of Hazzard*, the man of many hats is synonymous with success and one of most ubiquitous faces in all of pop culture.

John has also been seen in everything from the movies *Smokey and the Bandit* (Burt Reynolds), *Felicity: An American Girl Adventure* (Shailene Woodley), *Sydney White* (Amanda Bynes) and *Christmas In Tune* (co-starring with Reba McEntire) to regularly popping up on *Dr. Quinn*, *Medicine Woman*, *Nip/Tuck*, *The Secret Life of the American Teenager* and even showing off some of his own fancy footwork on *Dancing with the Stars*.

As a four-time chart-topping country artist with 19 albums to his credit, including a whopping 72 tracks within the last year alone, John Schneider could quite realistically be counted amongst the most prolific and recognized entertainers of all time.

John is known all the world over for hit singles such as *It's Now Or Never* (the top charting *Elvis Presley* cover of any genre ever), *Them Good Ol' Boys Are Bad*, *I've Been Around Enough To Know*, *Country Girls*, *It's A Short Walk from Heaven to Hell*, *I'm Gonna Leave You Tomorrow*, *What's a Memory Like You* (*Doing in a Love Like This*), *You're the Last Thing I Needed Tonight*, *At the Sound of the Tone*, *Take the Long Way Home*, *Love, You Ain't Seen the Last of Me* and *Ruffled Skirts* right up to *Walk a Mile in My Shoes*, which he performed on the 2018 finale of *Dancing with the Stars* after personally duking it out for seven highly heralded weeks.

Three mounted men, TWO GRINGOS and ONE MEXICAN wait behind nearby rocks for the stagecoach to pass then gallop out of the rocks with their guns blazing.

The two men aboard the stagecoach spin around to see the three bandits chasing them. The driver whips the horses and the stagecoach picks up speed as the guard readies his shotgun. For a few moments the stagecoach widens the distance and then the bandits begin to close in. The guard takes aim.

One of the gringos puts a bullet in the driver's back and he drops the reins and tumbles off the seat onto the ground. The guard fires both barrels knocking the gringo backwards out of the saddle. As the guard reloads the other two bandits close in, one on either side of the now out of control stagecoach. The Mexican shoots the guard in the back and he too, falls off the speeding coach.

The bandits draw alongside the excited horses and the Mexican leaps from his horse onto one of the coach horses and after a short struggle pulls them to a stop. He jumps off the horse, climbs up onto the boot, grabs the strongbox and throws it to the ground then jumps down. As the gringo dismounts the Mexican shoots the lock off the box and lifts the lid. Inside are bags of gold coins. The bandits exchange grins then begin to take the bags out of the strongbox.

On a nearby ridge a ruggedly-handsome young man, half-Mexican, half-Anglo wearing a black, flat-brimmed Stetson and the clothing of a Mexican caballero sits astride a horse watching. HE IS THE CABALLERO IN THE OPENING CREDITS. There is an amused, calculating expression in his blue eyes as he rolls a cigarette with his left hand and lights it. He is THE ARIZONA KID.

The bandits transfer the gold to their saddlebags then mount up. The gringo fires a shot into the air and the frightened horses take off with the empty coach. The bandits turn and ride off in the opposite direction.

The handsome caballero on the ridge calmly watches them for several moments- the way a jackal watches a flock of sheep- then gently spurs his horse and rides along the ridge following them.

Character Breakdowns

THE ARIZONA KID: A charming, ruggedly-handsome caballero, half Mexican, half-Anglo with a fast gun and a moral code. He has returned to Arizona after a five year absence to find the murderers of his parents and brother. He is somewhere between 25 and 30 year old.

JACK LASSITER: A tall, handsome, charming, deadly killer.

ANN REYNOLDS: A beautiful, young woman of 24 who has come to Arizona from Philadelphia to find her husband who had left her to search for gold.

CARMELA SANCHEZ: The beautiful 17 year old daughter of Miguel and Luisa Sanchez. She has been in love with The Arizona Kid since she was 12 and wants to marry him. She is a wholesome spitfire!

LUISA SANCHEZ: A Mexican beauty of about 35. She is a gutsy frontier woman which was very common in the late 1800s. She also sings and plays the guitar.

MIGUEL SANCHEZ: The lucky husband of beautiful Luisa. He is a rancher with steadfast courage; an honorable man with a heart of gold. He is in his mid-fifties and very much in love with his wife, Luisa. Five years earlier he had found the Arizona Kid with a bullet in his back and brought him to the ranch where he and Luisa nursed him back from certain death. They have become his surrogate family.

FELINA SANCHEZ: The five-year-old daughter of Luisa and Miguel Sanchez. Like her older sister Carmela she is beautiful, bright, brave, personable and rides a horse as good as any adult.

SHERIFF BUCK THOMAS: A tall, rugged, very brave man who has known The Arizona Kid since he was a small child. He has been the Sheriff of Dos Cabezas for many years.

NANTAHE: Apache Chief. He is a strong, very noble man in his mid-fifties whose large band of Apache were friends with The Arizona Kid's family.

WILSON: An outlaw and cattle rustler who has shot many a man in the back.

DOLORES OBREGON: A beautiful young woman who works in saloons and had fallen deeply in love with The Arizona Kid when he was away in Silver City, New Mexico. She is still madly in love with him.

HOTEL CLERK: A shifty-eyed man of about 40 who runs the only hotel in Dos Cabezas. He has the hots for Ann.

GRIJALVA: A Mexican-Apache who had taken over the cattle rustling business while Jack Lassiter was away in Texas. Now that Lassiter has returned Grijalva figures it's time he had a showdown with his old boss.

The rest of the cast consists of outlaws, Navajo, Chinese immigrants, Mexican villagers, preachers and various townsfolk.

Ray Saniger, 2nd Unit Director



Lee Holdridge has a deeply rich and varied background in film, opera, concert music and pop music. He was born in *Port-au-Prince, Haiti*. His mother was *Puerto Rican* and his father *American*. He spent his early years in *Costa Rica*, beginning music studies on the violin at the age of ten with *Hugo Mariani*, then as the conductor of the *National Symphony Orchestra*. At fifteen he moved to *Boston* to finish high school and study composition with *Henry Lasker*. Later, Holdridge moved to *New York* to continue his music studies and begin his professional career as a composer. While in *New York*, he wrote concert works, rock pieces, songs, theater music and background scores for short films.

Holdridge's successes in New York came to the attention of Neil Diamond who brought Holdridge to Los Angeles to write arrangements for Diamond's forthcoming albums and to work with Diamond on the score for the film Jonathan Livingston Seagull.

Since that time Holdridge has scored numerous film and television hits including *Splash*, *Big Business*, *Mr. Mom*, *Micki & Maude*, *Old Gringo*, *The Other Side of The Mountain Pt. II*, *Mustang Country*, *The Beastmaster*, *Jeremy* (Cannes Festival award winner), *The Tuskegee Airmen*, *Puerto Vallarta Squeeze* and the Academy Award winning documentary feature film *The Long Way Home*. Television shows include *Moonlighting*, *Beauty and the Beast*, the complete eight-hour remake of *East of Eden* and the miniseries *Mists of Avalon*.

Concert works include the *Concerto for Violin and Orchestra #2*, *The Fantasy Chorale* and the full-length opera *Dulce Rosa*, based on an *Isabel Allende* short story.

Lee is a Grammy Award winner and has won and been nominated for many other awards including Emmys and ASCAP.

Nikki has collected hundreds of authentic-to-the-period western costumes that will be used in ***The Sunset Rider.***




Raleigh Wilson

Boss Wrangler

Raleigh Wilson, for over 40 years, has entertained audiences on and off the screen as a rodeo rider, *The Marlboro Man* and an action film maker. A rodeo cowboy since 1958, Raleigh won many awards around the world: 1990 Montana Championship, 1979 National Finals Rodeo, 1980 California Championship, 1981 World Cup Rodeo in Australia, 1995 and retired after winning the Senior Pro National Championship.

During this period he was hired for the print *Marlboro Man* ads which led to motion picture work. In early 2002 Wilson opened *Rollywood Studios in Simi Valley, CA*, a 4,000 square foot green screen facility and production company, which opened its doors to independent film productions.

His film credits include *The Titanic, The Mummy, The Thin Red Line, Troy* and *The War Of The Worlds*.




Phil O'dell

Financials

We understand the importance of developing and keeping track of a film budget throughout. But because budgeting it's so critical to the filmmaking process, we'll expand.

By tracking our budget:

We can ensure we are able to film what our team has in mind. Knowing our costs per day after going through a script breakdown, ensures that the production plans are financially possible.

When an unexpected expense comes up, it will be far easier to have a clear cushion put aside for an issue. Plus, if needed, we can also reallocate part of the film's budget by being able to quickly see what can come off the existing budget.

Having a documented budget can affect the potential costs for specific talent and crew.

Our budget will also determine how much insurance coverage and premiums we expect to pay... as well as marketing costs.

Production and Marketing Highlights

According to the **Arizona Film and Digital Media Coalition (AFDMC)** the Tax Incentive for filming in Arizona with a \$10,000,000 budget is between 15 and 17%. Filming permits are already in place for Utah.

The National Hispanic Arts Council in Washington, D.C. will allow us access to all their social media, once approved. This is highly desirable to a distributor and to our production company when it comes to promoting and marketing the picture.

Budgets will be kept reasonable, organized and itemized including audit milestones.

Cast will include well-known stars and recognizable supporting players.

The picture will be geared for family viewing with an approximate PG/PG-13 rating. Lots of action with interesting, dynamic characters, humor, heart, romance and a moral message will be infused throughout.

Filmed in spectacular locations such as *Monument Valley, Tucson, Sedona* and other scenic spots in Arizona.

Our crews will consist local **IATSE (International Alliance of Theatrical and Stage Employees)** union workers to keep housing budgets down.

Genuine *Native Americans* such as the *Navajo* and *Apache* tribes will be employed to portray Indians instead of actors who are not *Native American*.

A franchise of the main character, **The Arizona Kid** will be created and produced at a projected rate of one every year. Basically, this is what *Hollywood* created with *The Cisco Kid* character beginning with the first talkie western in *Old Arizona* in 1928 that continued until 1949 with *Cesar Romero*; then *Gilbert Roland* up until ending with *Duncan Renaldo*. *Duncan Renaldo* then went on to play *The Cisco Kid* on television from 1949 to 1956. That franchise lasted 28 years!

With the Hispanic theater-going audience now at a whopping 26% and growing, it's high time to return to a *Hispanic* hero in an *American* western. **Just a few of the countries around the world that love westerns: The US, all of Central and South America, Japan, Italy, Germany, Spain, China, and more.**

The Sunset Rider will be debuted and play in theaters for a minimum of eight weeks to maximize box office returns... then released onto streaming services.

Marketing

Film Marketing has moved beyond the era of just posters and board signs that were used to promote movies. This new era demands that film marketing utilizes new technology involving the digital world, although poster imagery is part of this.

Our initial main objective is not to market the film but to create a great entertaining piece of art. However, marketing the film eventually becomes the main selling point of the entire project, without which our movie is nothing but a mere two-hour-long video.

The marketing and promotion budget for The Sunset Rider is included into the production budget. This also includes an on set photographer, poster design, collateral and development of digital media pieces.
